# Information

## Registration

1. Complete the registration form at the back of the booklet, listing your child's class selection(s) in the appropriate time slot(s). Be sure to also indicate a second choice whenever one is available.
2. If your child is not interested in a full summer school schedule of four classes, be sure that you do not skip a period when selecting classes. We will not have any supervision available to watch children between classes.
3. Return the completed registration form directly to the Trevor Grade School office before June 1, 2010. Class sizes are limited and will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. Students required to attend summer school will have first priority for any class. It is suggested that you return the registration early. If a first-choice class is full, not available, or cancelled, we will try to schedule your second choice. Parents will be notified of any changes.
4. Individual student summer school schedules will be sent out the week before summer school begins. Please pay your fees as soon as possible afterwards. Refunds will not be given once the final schedules have been sent out.

## Attendance

1. Classes for grades 3-8 will be held at Trevor Grade School. Students are expected to attend all of their summer school classes for the entire three-week period, so please schedule family vacations and other events accordingly.
2. If your child is unable to attend a day due to illness or an emergency, please notify the school before 7:45 AM at 862-2356.



# Information

## **Dress & Conduct**

1. Students are expected to dress according to the weather. Remember, some of the classroom areas of our building are not air-conditioned.
2. Please remember that summer school is an optional program for most students. Proper conduct, as outlined in your current Student Handbook, is expected at all times to ensure the smooth and successful operation of summer school. Students who cause disruption will be dropped from summer school classes.
3. The summer school program is meant to be rewarding for everyone. No refunds will be made for students asked to leave due to misconduct.

## **Guests**

1. Due to the amount of information to be covered in our summer school program and the fact that class sizes are limited, please do not send guests with your child. Expecting us to make "one" exception for your child will only open the door for many more.

## **Transportation**

1. The District does not provide transportation for its summer school program. Transportation of students to and from summer school is the responsibility of parents. Please remember this before committing your child to any classes.
2. Students must be picked up immediately upon their final dismissal each day. Supervision will not be provided for students remaining after their last class or after 11:55 AM

Current Grades: 3-5, 6-8

### **Writers Workshop**

**Cost: \$2.00**

Current Grades: 3-5

## Reading Enrichment

Current Grades: 3-4, 4-5

This class focuses on higher level thinking skills and provides enriching activities to extend reading comprehension and written and oral expression.

## Geometry Constructions

**Cost: \$2.00**

Current Grades: 5-8

Learn how to use geometry tools to construct geometric shapes. Students will examine the vocabulary, designs, and spatial elements of geometry. Activities include using a compass, measuring, and making geometric designs.

## Math Cooks

**Cost: \$10.00**

Current Grades: 3-5

Use your developing math skills to prepare tasty treats! Scrumptious recipes will be prepared in one class period to reinforce addition, subtraction, division, and multiplication.

## Math in Our World

## Mathematical Mystery Tour

Current Grades: 6-8

Let this geographically alive mystery tour integrate math into art, science, philosophy, history, social studies, and language arts. The use of calculators, geometrical constructions, metric measurement, problem solving, formulating results is woven throughout the class.



# Physical Education

## Hunter Safety

**Cost: \$10.00**

Current Grades: 5-8

The basic Hunter Safety course consists of a minimum of 10 hours of safety instruction. Students learn how hunting accidents are caused and how they can be prevented. Hunter responsibility and safety are stressed throughout the classes, which consist of lectures, demonstrations, group discussions, practical exercises, and individual study and activity assignments. There is an additional fee of \$10 for this course and a mandatory Saturday session at a local firing range.
